

Berlin Fact Sheet

The **Hotel Concorde Berlin** is centrally located just off the fashionable **Kurfürstendamm Boulevard** in the heart of the City West. It is only 100 meters from the **Kaiser Wilhelm Memorial Church**, and within walking distance of the **Zoologischer Garten**.



Kurfürstendamm, known locally as Ku'damm is one of the most famous avenues in Berlin. This prestigious tree lined boulevard plays host to designer stores and jewellers from the likes of Gucci, Chanel and Cartier and is home to the famous Kaiser Wilhelm memorial Church, which still holds its scars from a bombing raid in 1943 in which it was badly damaged.



Situated on the Kurfürstendamm, the Kaiser Wilhelm Memorial Church is a stark reminder of Berlin's often turbulent history and the air raids that shook the city in WWII. Originally built in the 1890s, the present church now consists of the original building with an attached foyer and a separate belfry and chapel. The damaged spire of the old church has been retained and its ground floor has been made into a memorial hall.



Zoologischer Garten is the oldest and most well known zoo in Germany, opening in 1844. Today with over 1400 species and 14,000 animals the zoo presents a comprehensive collection.

Other must see attractions in Berlin:

The **Reichstag**, the landmark **Fernsehturm**, and **Potsdamer-Platz**, in which visitors can still see original sections of the Berlin Wall.

Countless restaurants and bars cater for families and party-goers alike; whatever you're looking for you'll find it in Berlin!
